

A30 Trebursye to Two Bridges Resurfacing works

A30 Trebursye to Two Bridges – overnight closures for resurfacing

We're resurfacing the A30 between Trebursye and Two Bridges. This will maintain and improve safety for everyone using the road, and reduce the need for any unplanned closures.

We'll be carrying out this work on weeknights between 8pm and 6am, when there is less traffic on the road. Works will start from the evening of Monday 2 December. It will take us up to seven weeks.

During the day the road will be open as usual.

Please note, there will be no overnight works between Friday 20 December and Monday 6 January.

Closure and diversion information

We'll have phased overnight weeknight closures (from 8pm to 6am) on the A30. The A30 will be open as usual during the day and at weekends:

- **Monday 2 to Tuesday 3 December:** westbound exit slip at Trebursye closed overnight. We'll be using a convoy system on the A30. This means the A30 is still open, but you will be taken past the working area behind a traffic vehicle at a reduced speed.

Diversion: continue on A30 and leave via Kennards House exit and use local road network via E Park.

- **Thursday 5 to Thursday 19 December:** westbound A30 closed overnight between Trebursye junction and Kennards House

Diversion: via E Park

- **Tuesday 07 January to Monday 13 January:** westbound entry slip at Kennards House closed overnight. We'll be using a convoy system on the A30. This means the A30 is still open, but you will be taken past the working area behind a traffic vehicle at a reduced speed.

Diversion: use the eastbound A30 and go to the Pennygillam exit, where you can join the westbound carriageway.

- **Thursday 9 January and Monday 13 January:** overnight closure of South Petherwin junction during convoy system on the A30.

Diversion: leave at Kennards House Junction to follow local network route.

- **Tuesday 14 January to Thursday 16 January, and Tuesday 21 January:** Overnight closure of East/West Link during convoy system on the A30.

Diversion: use the A30 eastbound carriageway to leave via A30 Kennards House exit where you can rejoin the A30.

- **Thursday 16 January:** overnight closure of Treguddick (Distillery) Junction during convoy system on the A30. Access will be maintained for properties within closure.
- **Tuesday 21 January – Wednesday 22 January:** Overnight closure of West/East Link during convoy system on the A30.

Diversion: use the westbound A30 to go to Five Lanes exit, where you can join the eastbound carriageway.

This work is subject to favourable weather conditions, for example heavy rain may affect the progress. If we're unable to complete our work as planned, we may need to continue beyond the dates stated above.

Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journeys.

Access will be maintained to properties within the closure.
