Mrs Harrison reported to the Parish Council of water leaks from Lane End Cottage, and she has spoken to the Chief Exec regarding this matter as there has been 4 leeks in the past two weeks. It was reported to Mrs Harrison that works will be carried out in March 2019 of a duration period of 4 weeks to resolve the problem.

Mrs J Terry addressed the Parish Council regarding the Defib as the bulb has yet again blown since the replacement in the summer, as a result it may not be the bulb but the electrics and therefore the Parish Council are happy for M Hart of Callington to carry out the works if needed.

- 6.1 <u>Car Park Village Hall</u> A Quote has been received from M Hart for the installation of lighting for the top car park for the village Hall, they have provided 3 options
 - Option A LED Flood Light on Gable End Wall £353.84 plus VAT
 - Option B 2 LED Flood Lights attached to a Mast on Gable End Wall £639.48 plus VAT

Option C – As option B with additional bollard lightening within the Overflow Car Park £2588.94 plus VAT Option A would cast too many shadows and therefore making it dangerous to walk down. Option C is unnecess-

sary Cllrs would like to choose option B Proposed 1st Cllr C Marshall 2nd Cllr J Grahame with all Cllrs in favour.

- 6.2 <u>CCC Planning</u> CCC has responded to the Clerk regarding the issue recently raised with them. Unfortunately, nothing can be done apart from what the Clerk is already doing with referencing the applications.
- 6.3 <u>Community Grants</u> Coads Green Community Centre have requested £3529.00 for repairs maintenance and paint to Village Hall. Crockery for Village Hall £512.99. Supply and install hot water heater for kitchen £890.00 a

total of £4931.99. Cllrs are happy to support Coads Green Community Centre by donating a Grant for the crockery and for the water heater in the kitchen £1040.00.

North Hill Playgroup would like to apply for a grant for toys and an outside storage shed totalling £1500.00. Cllrs are happy to donate this amount.

Coads Green School would like to apply for new dictionaries thesaurus and new camera costing £750.00. Cllrs are happy to donate this amount
